Cate outlined one aspect of the work of the Northern Centre does in the West Ryde and Epping communities. This was the **SafeT** pilot program, run for the protection of women who have recently left a violent relationship. The program was due to end in December of this year but funding has now been secured for a further twelve months.

Cate runs a diverse operation with staff able to assist a variety of nationalities, with understanding and financial support for single women, women with children and even families with their pets.

Funding support is a constant challenge for her organisation and I have asked Cate to let us know if we can assist in some way, in the future.
