The ninth cohort of Community Service Year (CSY) volunteers has successfully completed their volunteering and are now heading to higher education institutions across Tanzania. We are thrilled to inform you that Brenda has been accepted into the Institute of Accountancy Arusha, located in Arusha, and will be pursuing a Bachelor of Tourism and Hospitality with Apprenticeship.

This year, all 131 of our volunteers made a significant impact in their communities. Out of these, 93 volunteers taught over 22,000 students across 38 secondary schools in the Arusha and Manyara regions, while the rest worked in various departments at St Jude's.
