Last week we welcomed former member Rod Mitchell who presented an interesting talk about the Snowy 2.0.

We learned that Snowy 2.0 commenced in 2019 and was due to be completed by 2023, however now is due to finish in 2028. Delay has been partly caused through severe bushfires, covid and initial engineering deficiencies. Being constructed by Salini (an Italian firm) it will link two existing dams, Tantangara and Talbingo through a 27 km underground tunnel to generate power to NSW and other states. It seems the initial quote by using Google maps is not always the best alternative. Already massively over budget, the current estimated cost of \$12billion, will surely be exceeded. Secretary Peter, asked could the money be better spent – no one had an answer.

Rod also spoke about his bus driving experiences in the Kosciuszko National Park both getting tourists around and getting workers to and from the actual construction sites. We also took the opportunity to thank Rod for bussing the 3rd Age of Rock Orchestra to Gosford from the Northern Beaches a fortnight ago for our concert.
