#### FROM PRESIDENT DAVID'S KEYBOARD.....

Last week Janelle Craig from West Pennant Hills & Cherrybrook Club, assisted by Mary-Ann from Kariong Somersby Club gave us a presentation about District 9685's Respectful Relationships program.

This program is one of 55 projects within our District being held by various clubs to combat domestic violence and coercive control in our society; a sad fact that it still exists. It is obvious that a generational change is desperately needed.

Two aspects of the Respectful Relationships program that took my notice, were the Safe Hands Educational Bursaries (\$500 to

children of family violence – 4 to be given on the Central Coast to help them experience "normal schooling", and the Strong Arms Scholarships for adult survivors of DV to obtain their TAFE or University qualifications (\$1,000 each).

I feel these are well worthy of our support and were discussed at this week's Board Meeting.

Another of the 55 projects, is a program to place educators in schools to address the generational occurrence of domestic violence in an attempt to stop the cycle.
