At our meeting last week we heard from Fran Baines, who volunteers at We Care Connect.

Members were somewhat surprised by the numbers involved in the support given to children, including babies, across the Central Coast by this local group who have identified a need and set up facilities to deal with it in 2016. Has now grown to include a large warehouse in Wyong that provides so much help to children living on poverty. We Care Connect has 150 volunteers who work to make up the packages and bags for children referred to them by local Case Workers.

It is the first year We Care Connect supported 1,300 children, last year it was 10,500. Last year 140,000 items of clothes; 21,000 items of linen; 1,900 nappy packs including 92,000 nappies; 221 bassinets and cots; 272 car seats; 247 prams; 99,945 books and 10,225 toys were given to the children in need. Most of these are rehomed items with a small number of donated new items. These numbers are staggering and it is tragic that there are so many in need in our society. Our donations over the past 2 years have certainly not been wasted and I will make sure that tickets to this year's Razzamatazz are made available to the group. Drop off points are located around the Coast; they are listed on the We Care Connect website if you have items that would help.
