# BIOGRAPHY OF DISTRICT GOVERNOR NIRANJAN DEODHAR

With Open Orbit he brings together his expertise in Lean Six Sigma, sustainable process change, and insights in technology to create and build a new software platform for executives, managers and workers looking for practical methods and techniques in process improvement. Niranjan brings extensive experience in senior roles in companies like Genpact (an offshoot of GE), IBM, PwC, Rothmans, and Siemens. He has worked on building new business, creating consulting capabilities and implementing change programs in a variety of cultural and geographic contexts in Australia, India and the Silicon Valley, US.

Niranjan and his wife Vinita joined Rotary together in 2017 and share a passion for tackling pressing issues faced by

communities. Both were named Paul Harris Fellows. Vinita is a seasoned senior executive with deep experience in leading change and enhancing enterprise performance in complex environments.
