At our last meeting, John Kitchener and Maya from Yuendumu School (NT) gave us a very interesting look at education in remote communities.

The visual presentation showed us the valuable, and far different approach to how we were taught at school; a program that John has instigated at the school. Yuendumu has around a population of 1,000 and the local language is spoken in Warlpiri. The school teaches both Warlpiri and English.

The program is called Pina Jarri Kalu Ngurraraku, (Learning In Country Program) and involves taking the students into the surrounding bush area accompanied by local elders and Warlpiri teachers, who have a great cultural knowledge that is passed onto the students. These experiences have the children highly engaged which has led to a greater learning of not only arithmetic, language and writing, but also their local culture and care of the land.

John is to be highly commended for the program that he has worked on and introduced to the school. A program that is generating positive results and has led to other remote community schools showing interest in implementing the program.
