We all recalled the 3 days cease fire in the Gaza – Israel war, which Barry was able to tell us that this was to allow the WHO to conduct a vital polio vaccination program with tens of thousands of doses administered. A brief history of the polio eradication program as an initiative of Rotary was also retold. Barry got his information from an article in the monthly Rotary Down Under magazine, October issue.
