The first is a project to send a container load of paediatric wheelchairs to a disabled school in South Africa. Theresa Behrens approached us via the website to seek our support. Theresa is from South Africa and worked in a school for disabled children before moving to Australia a few years ago and knows of the desperate need. Barry has contacted a Club in England who is currently sending wheelchairs to South Africa to get a handle on costs and processes. There are a number of parts of this project to be sorted out yet before it can proceed, but it will be good for us to do.

Second proposed project would be funded from next year's Razzamatazz. The Glen for Women is seeking help for one of three ideas — solar installation at their centre buildings, a vehicle to get clients to appointments and part time work, or funds to allow the construction of a sports area at the Centre (have raised \$80,000 of the anticipated cost of \$100,000).

A number of members attended the funeral of Margaret Medlicott, wife of longstanding past member Peter Medlicott, last Friday to support

Peter on this sad occasion and to farewell Margaret.

At the Board Meeting last Monday, it was decided to support The Glen for Women with the purchase of a new car, as the major beneficiary for the 2025 Razzamatazz, which is scheduled for 15 April 2025. Other funds committed were the sponsorship of one child in the Smith Family Learning for Life Program and also \$1,000 to Orange Sky.

Jenny Allen won the head and tails, and PP PHF Warren Bolton won the card draw but could only draw the 10 of spades. Jackpot grows to \$61 tonight.
