At our last meeting, Rebecca Shoebridge, Compliance Manager, and Sara Salmons, Operations Manager, gave us an interesting look at the rehabilitation program that is provided by The Glen For Women at Wyong Creek.

The program is based on the Aboriginal Drug and Alcohol Residential Rehabilitation Network (ADARRN) model of care. Culture is a centrepiece of the program.

The 12-week residential program includes group and one-on-one counselling, support groups and skills building programs. Clients can also attend other wellbeing and self-help sessions outside of the core program. Practical activities including weaving, care of property, and in the kitchen are also part of the program.

The Glen for Women commenced in 2022 and there is a long waiting list for entry to the successful program.

This year The Glen For Women is the major beneficiary for our Razzamatazz Project, and a car will be purchased.

The car will have many uses including to run the clients around for appointments, part time work, outside activities, family time and driving lessons.
