The meeting on April 16 had reasonable attendance. The Guest Speaker for this meeting was Club Secretary, PHF Peter Moore, who completed his "series" of Medical Anecdotes.

Following Rotary Grace, President Nev provided the International Toast to The Rotary Club of Budapest Centre, Hungary. This followed the media release from the newly elected Hungarian Prime Minister, Pyotr Magyar, who asked his defeated opponent, Viktor Orban, a populist Putin ally, to resign immediately so that the country may begin reparation works, following 16 years of neglect during Orban's reign. Magyar, who under Hungarian law, would normally take over at the end of May 2026, was swept into power with a massive 67% primary vote, amongst a record voter turnout! Hungarian people sang & danced all over the country as the result was announced last Saturday evening. It is thought that Hungary has one of the most recognisable Parliamentary buildings in the world.
