What is Generation Connection?

Inspired by the hit ABC TV show Old People's Home for Four-Year-Olds, Generation Connection creates opportunities for older Australians and young children to play games at their school and go on excursions together.

Every school holidays we create three days of fun experiences. This year we will be telling stories, learning how to draw, and playing bowls together. These days are designed to create opportunities for teaching and deep conversations.



How can this program benefit you?

Our aim is to build meaningful connections across generations. We want our children to have fun socialising with older adults in the community, and to give older adults a unique opportunity to connect with young children.

We are here to build confidence and encourage joy. We want to see two generations sharing knowledge and skills. Most importantly, we want to give everyone a fun day.

Who will be running the program?

Their Care is a provider of children's after school care and holiday programming. We serve over 350 schools across New-South Wales, Victoria and Western Australia. We are a leader in child care space and pride ourselves on enriching all of our children's lives.
