INTRODUCING OUR SPEAKER FOR JUNE 22, 2017, Wilfred Chee's Rotary experience in Australia and his Journey from Buddhism to Christianity

Wilfred arrived in Australia as a 17-year-old student to complete his last two years of high school prior to entering university. He first attended De La Salle College in Cronulla, where he experienced true friendship from a Rotarian from Sutherland who managed a timber factory.

Since graduating from university as a biochemist Wilfred entered the Christian Ministry as a minister and served a total of 45 years both in Malaysia and Australia in that capacity.

Wilfred joined Rotary in 1975 when he was; and still is a minister at the Chinese Christian Church at Milson's Point. He didn't expect to qualify joining Rotary as a businessman, but was informed that he was in "business for the Lord" and was fully qualified to be a Rotarian.

Wilfred has greatly enjoyed his Rotary years and was surprised to be made a Paul Harris fellow last year.

He lists as his hobbies Chinese Painting, Preparing Sermons, Line Dancing, Table Tennis and Aqua Swimming.

Wilfred has also written a book about which he will tell us.



Last Weeks Guest Speaker

Last week we heard from Tim Howard of Destiny Rescue Australia, an International, not-for profit organization dedicated to rescuing, restoring & reintegrating children who have been lured, sold or trafficked into sexual exploitation.



Five girls were rescued and three perpetrators arrested in a recent karaoke TV (KTV) bar raid in the Philippines. The raid was a combined effort between the antitrafficking police, the Department of Social Welfare and Development, the Department of Labor, and Destiny

Rescue agents.

Police arrested the mamasan, the manager of the bar, and the owner of the bar. The Destiny Rescue agents and Department of Social Welfare and Development officers accompanied the girls to a safe location, from which they will be placed in aftercare facilities.


CLUB CHANGEOVER DINNER
