It was a privilege to hear Jeff's experience about his earlier life whilst working on various properties in Northern NSW and Queensland. This was to fulfil his dream of becoming proficient with all aspects of farming and living on the land. Thus, he gained extensive experience from managing livestock to growing various crops, such as cotton soya beans wheat and oats.

Of particular interest was hearing the challenges he had with managing Brahman cross bred steers, which were difficult beasts to handle.

Other livestock he managed included Hereford Cows and Black Angus cattle.

Following on from his previous talk we learnt that after getting married to Trish in 1969 and living in a little old house called "Wee Wally" for a year they moved to Queensland to manage a small property in Maryborough.

Following that and by now having two young sons in the family they moved to Manilla Qld for a time to manage a property bought by Harry H. Miller.

The final 3 years of Jeff's country experience was in Narrabri prior to coming to Sydney to ensure that his two boys would receive an excellent education.

Jeff recounted numerous interesting stories from the various properties, including the many snakes they encountered inside and outside of their living quarters. There was even a time he had to shoot one of them to get rid of it!

The experience of hard work and challenging times proved a real asset and served him in good stead for his now 40 years with Trent Driving School.


