It was great to hear that we have secured Alan Jones as the Master of Ceremonies for the evening! – Guaranteed to sell out the event which is already heavily subscribed!

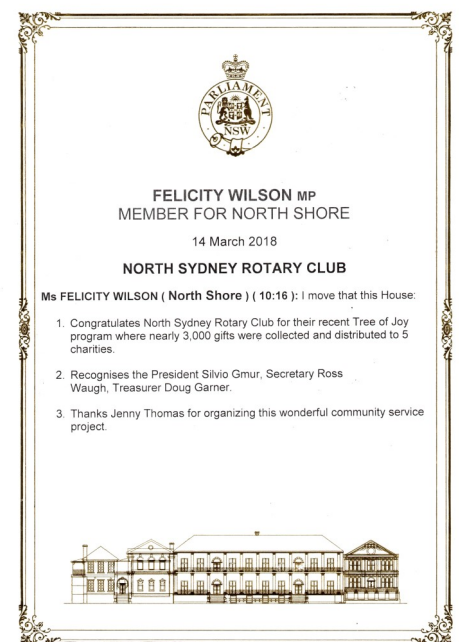
