What a wonderful day we all had last meeting at the Changeover Lunch.

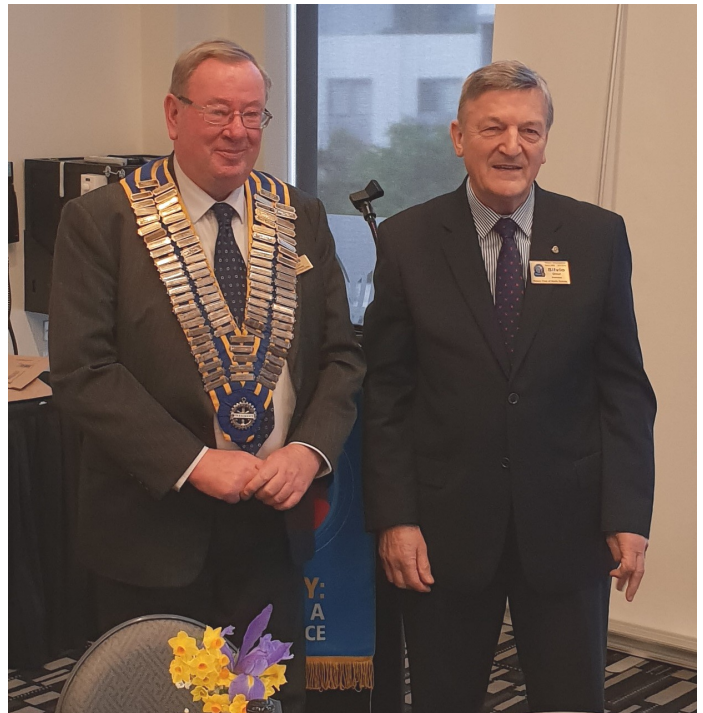
All our members in attendance with the exception of Robert Lau who is on Leave of Absence.

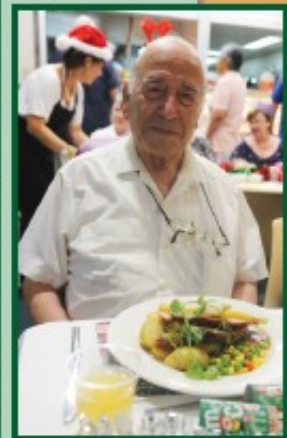
