Guest Speaker for Meeting 8th November

Dr Graham Kenny, from Mosman Rotary spoke to us on the Future of Manufacturing in Australia. Dr Kenny came with a background in strategy and performance management, having spent many years helping organisations through educating managers through seminars, through consulting work and through the written word.

Graham pointed out the large reduction in the manufacturing sector in Australia over the past 50 years, which has dropped from 29% of Gross Domestic Product to the present 5%. This is caused by the marked difference in the cost of production between Australia and its northern neighbours and Graham suggested that the present low percentage would remain at this low figure.

The lower manufacturing rate does not seem to have affected the local standard of living which, with increased technology has continued to rise. Improved efficiency means a smaller work force in making goods here, but this was a reason to be worried. Australia has an open and adaptive economic and political system which being inclusive and not extractive gave us advantages over other countries.

A thought-provoking speaker who spent some time answering several complex questions and we all came away thinking better of this wide brown land.
