100 Years of Rotary in Australia 1921-2021

The first Rotary Club was established in the USA in 1905 as a collegial grouping of businessmen. It took as its symbol a machine cog or wheel. In 1928 the Rotary Foundation was established with a goal of furthering international peace and goodwill. Since then the Foundation has raised over four billion US dollars in avd funding.

The movement spread to Australia in 1921. A North Sydney branch was established in 1928 and continues to serve the community. Rotary Australia is now part of the South Pacific zone of Rotary International.
