We had a very congenial meeting last Thursday and welcomed Jeff Hudson, a director of the Children First Foundation (CFF), an organisation started by Rotary Clubs in Melbourne some years ago and has grown exponentially in more recent times. CFF sources young disabled patients from the Asia Pacific region and brings them to Australia for free medical treatment much the same as ROMAC, INTERPLAST, OPERATION CLEFT and RAWCS. Doctors and nurses donate their expertise, hospitals their accommodation and after their operations the young people are taken to a Rehabilitation Hospital/Farm at Kilmore in Victoria until they and their carer are able to travel.

The rehabilitation farm was donated by a generous Rotarian and committee member of CFF.

A carer (generally a parent) travel with the patient and remain with them in Australia. Our president has known Jeff for quite some time but never known about his philanthropic activities with CFF. Although Jeff lives on the north shore, whenever I ring him or he rings me he seems to be in Melbourne and now I know why.

Jeff was an inspiration to us all at our meeting and you could have heard a pin drop during his presentation.


