Well the trailer raffle is 'done and dusted' as they say for this year. We had our last selling day on Saturday at Pennant Hills Marketplace, the third time we had been there this year. Our morning crew was John Ellis, Ida Shi and Adrian Bell. At 11.30 they were replaced by Ahmadul Ameen, Anoop Sud, Phil Stanton and David Firth. Again the response was fairly quiet with just 106 tickets sold and takings of \$366.70.

So, with all ticket books returned and accounted for, we have sold 3,145 tickets with total takings of \$10,856.15. This is very similar to last year when we raised \$11,216.00. But by far the highlight of this years effort was that of Daisy Huang who, single handedly sold 600 tickets - yes, that's 12 books - and raised \$2,052.00! Great work Daisy! And thanks to all who came along and sold tickets on the Saturdays, rain, hail or shine, and to Pat Parker who set up the authority to sell at each of the shopping centres. Finally, a big thank you to our 2 major sponsors, Bunnings Dural who provided several hundred dollars worth of items for the trailer, and Terry Pankhurst who once again supplied the trailer all fitted out and registered.
