SHELTERBAG PROJECT UPDATE MAY 2023

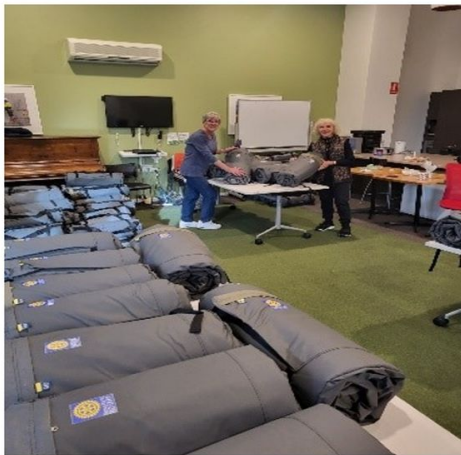
The Rotary Club of Mount Waverley in Victoria received their shipment of Shelterbags on Thursday 11th May.

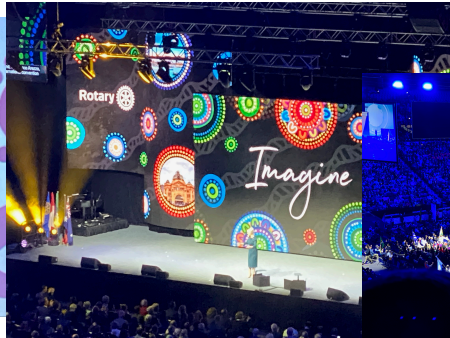
Speaker last month Jodi Rodgers
