It is almost time for our AGM on Tuesday 11th December. Our Bylaws state:-

“Article 3 Election of Directors and Officers

Section 1 -

(a) At a regular meeting one month prior to the annual general meeting, the presiding officer shall ask for nominations by Members of the Club for President-Nominee, President-Elect (if the position is vacant), Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Sergeant-at-arms and Directors.

(b) The nominations shall be presented by Members to the Secretary in writing at least 7 days before the time for election. The nominations duly

made shall be placed on a ballot in alphabetical order under the positions of President-Nominee, President-Elect, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Sergeant-at-arms and Directors and shall be voted for at the annual general meeting.

(c) The candidate for President-Nominee receiving a majority of the votes shall be declared elected to that office and shall serve as President-Elect for the year commencing on the first day of July next following the election and shall assume office as President on 1 July immediately following that year.

(d) The candidate for President-Elect receiving a majority of the votes shall be declared elected to that office and shall serve as President-Elect until assuming office as President on the following first day of July.

(e) The candidates for Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer and Sergeant-at-arms receiving a majority of the votes shall be declared elected to those positions and take office the following first day of July.

(f) The candidates for Director receiving a majority of the votes shall be declared elected as Directors and take office the following first day of July.”

Nomination forms will be available at our Club meeting on Tuesday 6th November. Full voting procedures and job description for all positions can be read in the Bylaws of the Rotary Club of Woy Woy Inc., a copy of which is attached with this bulletin.






