School Exams

Beside Christmas, December also means 1st semester exams for all of the children. This usually happens at the end of November in to early December. The written exams will happen for 1 week and in the following week, they will undertake practical tests. So, before our children are busy with the Christmas events, they have to be focused, study hard and be tested on every school subject they have studied for the past 6 months.

Palu Disaster

An earthquake, magnitude 7,4 occurred on 28 September 2018 off the coast of Central Sulawesi island. This triggered tsunami which swept through the city of Palu, and another coastal towns including Donggala.

Two of homes were in that region. None of the children or staff were injured, and the main buildings remained intact. Both had slight damage – the Girls Home to front gates and the Boys Home to a boundary wall. Temporary solutions were quickly identified and carried out. As ongoing recovery happens a more permanent solution will be put in place.
