Project 36-2009-10 # Indonesia continues to meet its current aims and objectives.

Rotary Club of Southport and Rotary e-Club Jakarta Gunawarman and Salvation Army, Indonesia have adopted proposals to improve this project to support sustainability and better outcomes for students.

Australian Rotary Club sponsors are responsible for improved education outcomes for all students in nine (of 17) Salvation Army Homes in Indonesia. We entreat all Rotary Clubs to raise their commitment to minimum **\$550** per annum to achieve this goal. Currently ten Rotary Clubs have agreed to this.
