Report on meeting 16 March 2021.

Seven members and two visiting Rotarians met at the Overells for an informal meeting about the future of Southport Rotary. DG Andy and DG elect Jeff Egan came along to participate in the discussion .

Pres Andrew told us we can continue as a club with the present three executives and we can decide where and when we meet. The survey of members got 13 replies on the question of becoming a satellite club of Broadwater club. To be viable the satellite club needs 10 members and that support was not forthcoming from members. The thought of

handing back our charter was not a happy option so the idea that we continue as a Rotary club but with changes in our way of functioning met with support from the meeting. Andrew spoke of the support Broadwater offered if we had wished to join them as a satellite club and said he would promptly write to the president explaining our position and thanking the club for their support.

We may have a more social structure in the future but would be most happy to join with Broadwater in some of their projects.. We do have 18 members but often only have six attend a meeting. Several members never come, some due to health reasons and others due to work travel or excused attendance. The room cost of \$100 at the Tavern since the start of this year has been a matter of great concern and we will seek a new venue. The Ashmore mens shed was suggested as a possible venue as Southport Rotary put over \$70,000 into the project. There is a separate meeting room and kitchen that Ashmore club use for some of their meetings.

If we stay as a club our bank accounts can continue and the various funds we hold for Griffith scholarships and the gift from Cyril Richarde can all continue to be allowed to function as previously. Our membership fees are less than Broadwater Club and we can continue to reach out to other Rotary organisations to be allowed to participate in some of their projects. The fact that we are a club of senior citizens is a major part of our problem but we have existed for over 75 years and there is a strong desire among members that we should continue even in a more limited capacity.

We may be able to join in the mens shed projects activities in fund raising such as the Bunnings sausage sizzle. We plan to notify Ferry Rd Tavern immediately and Lionel and Merv offered to remove our material from the hotel and store it at Lionel's home. Pres Andrew will notify members as soon as possible of the decision made this evening and hoped most would continue their membership of the club.

There are many things still to be resolved but both the DG and DGN wished us all the best and offered full support for our path ahead.

Peter O went off and brought back pizzas for our meal together and these together with the very pleasant red wine offered made for a very pleasant evening of fellowship enjoying the kind hospitality of the Overells.

Our next meeting venue will be announced as soon as possible.

PS. The hotel offered to reduce the room hire charge to \$50 per meeting. We will consider this at our next meeting.
