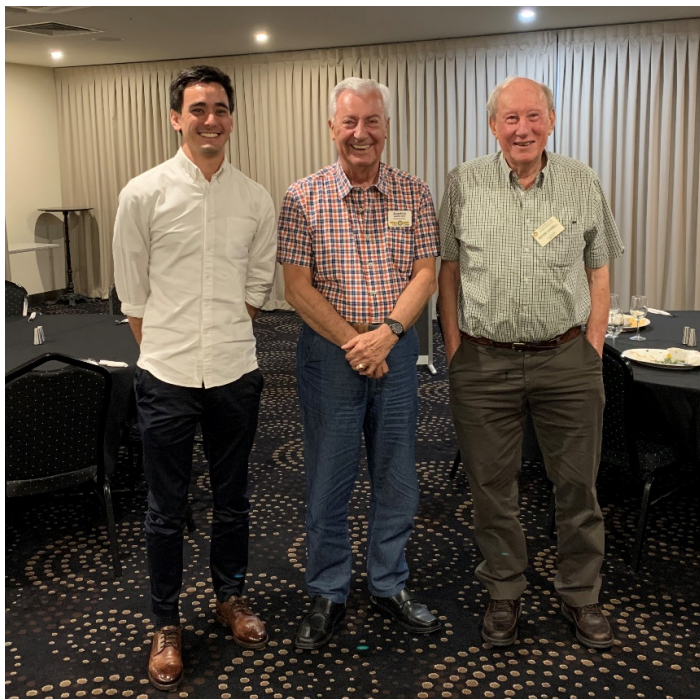

Dear All,

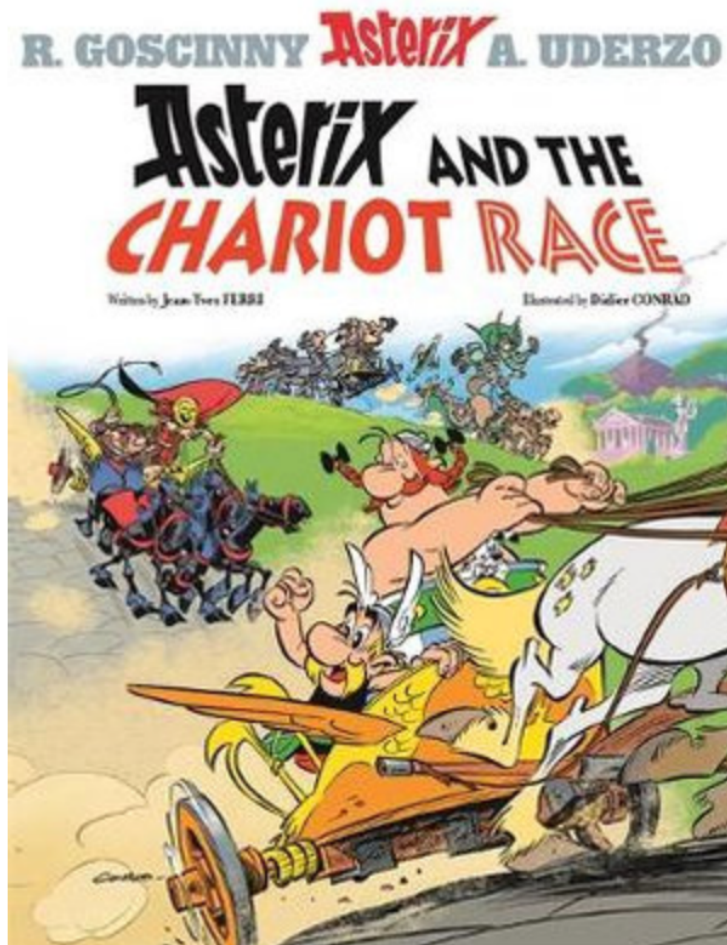
