Rotary and "All That Jazz" Golf Tournament

Founded in 1916, the **Rotary Club of Ottawa** is the <u>longest existing service club in the National Capital Region</u>. Our members are business, professional and public service executives who support high ethical standards in their business dealings and create community service projects in Ottawa and abroad. We are a member club in Rotary International (<u>www.rotary.org</u>) with more than 33,000 clubs and well over one million members worldwide.

Your sponsorship will help our many worthwhile charitable projects such as **The Ottawa Rotary Home** (www.rotaryhome.on.ca). The Ottawa Rotary Home was the first respite facility established in North America. From 1982-2009, a 12-bed facility provided loving out-of-home care to children/youth with physical disabilities or complex medical needs, giving families a short but valued respite from the responsibilities of caring for their child. In 2009, the Ottawa Rotary Home expanded with the building of a new \$6 million facility at Bank Street and Leitrim Road. The building provides 13 beds for children/youth and includes an 8-bed wing devoted to young adults.

Other Rotary Club of Ottawa activities include our *Adventure in Citizenship* program where each spring our club brings over 200 senior high school students from across Canada to Ottawa for an intensive four-day program in Canadian citizenship and civic responsibility. Notable alumni from this 67 year-old initiative include Adrienne Clarkson, Ed Broadbent and Joe Clark. In the last six years our club helped establish children's aid and literacy programs in a variety of developing countries and contributed over \$30,000 to polio eradication and disaster relief efforts around the globe.
