2018 ROTARY ADVENTURE IN CITIZENSHIP PROGRAM

Dear Participant and Parents:

On behalf of the Rotary Club of Ottawa, I welcome your interest in participating in the Rotary Adventure in Citizenship Program. The program will take place April 29 to May 2, 2018 in the National Capital Region. (You will arrive in Ottawa on Saturday, April 28, 2018.)

The Rotary Adventure in Citizenship Program, now in its 68th year, provides a unique opportunity for participants to meet their peers from every part of Canada and to discuss and debate with them issues facing Canada today. It also gives participants the opportunity to see "behind-the-scenes" at many of our National institutions, an opportunity that is usually not available to either visitors or residents of the National Capital Region. A unique component of the program is the billeting of participants with host families. The participants can expect to return home tired, thrilled by the experience, with many new friends, and often with their assumptions about Canada significantly changed.

The Rotary Adventure in Citizenship Program is organized and managed by volunteer members of the Rotary Club of Ottawa. Our Club, participating agencies, and the host families, take very seriously our responsibilities to the participants in the program during their visit to the National Capital Region. In the sixty plus years the program has run, no participant has suffered any serious accident or injury. However, participants and their families must understand and accept that there is always a risk of accidental injury or other unfortunate incident that can occur. The Club, its members, the participating agencies and the host families can not be expected to bear liability should such an accident or incident take place. In order to minimize risks the participants must refrain from conduct that could jeopardize their own well-being or the well-being of others.

Attached are a Parental Consent/Participant's Undertaking and Expectations of Participants forms. Please complete and sign the forms and return it to your sponsoring Rotary Club for delivery to us. The delivery of the signed forms is required to enroll the participant in the program.

Finally, let me add a word regarding the time the participants will be spending with their host family. You will be a guest of a family that shares our commitment to the program. Your host family has volunteered to provide you with meals, a place to sleep and transportation to and from program events. Please use your limited time with the host family to get to know them better and express your appreciation for their hospitality. Please do not ask your host to consent to any deviation from the program. A token gift and a note of thanks to the family when you leave Ottawa are always appreciated. There will always be two or more participants placed with each Host Family. Each Host Family has been properly screened by the Rotary Club of Ottawa.

Program activities will occupy the full day and into the evening. Your host family will expect you at the end of each day's schedule. Do not plan any additional activities during this program.

Adventure Guides will set appropriate time lines and departure times for each Adventure activity.
