## THE 4 WAY TEST SPEECH CONTEST:

Third was Moesha Rumph from Melville Senior High School sponsored by the Armadale RC and her subject was school bullying. She outlined the statistics and the effects of school bullying and spoke out of personal experience.

When the adjudicators returned Assistant Governor Wayne presented the results and certificates to each of the contestants. Congratulating all three contestants for their excellent presentations, he said that unfortunately there could only be one winner and announced that Moesha would be the contestant representing Zone 2 in the Grand Final at the District Conference. All three girls received the applause of the audience. Mike for the adjudicators spoke of how well all contestants had eye contact with the audience, excellent content to their speeches, good posture and gestures and made good reference to the 4 way test.. He offered his and the help of Rostrum members to the students if they wished to develop their abilities further.
