GUEST SPEAKER: Kero O'Shea
TOPIC: Rethinking Membership

There has been a decline in membership in Australia and South Pacific despite the increased numbers of people involved in volunteering. As a result District have created a 3 year plan to rethink how we go about attracting and keeping members involved in Rotary.

Kero spoke to us about a number of things that are on the plan; including the need for us to make sure all our members are active and involved in what we are doing. It is not about compliance, but rather about engagement.

The District is looking at ways to improve training and education of new members, leaders and is seeking Rotary coaches to assist in this. They have set up a Facebook page and will be developing a webinar channel which will be launched in March.

Clubs can look at the social media that they are involved in and ask themselves if the first view that someone has of the club is impressive or not. If not – maybe some changes need to be made!

It is important to be flexible; and to look at all people who have been associated with the club in the past – to see if they can be re-connected to the club in some way.
