For each person who went, their \$20 was turned into \$25 which meant that 25 children will be saved from the awful impact that polio could have had on their lives.

It was a low budget film of \$23 million; which has already taken in over \$100 million in ticket sales so far.



GUEST SPEAKER: Troy Hendrickson

Troy has visited our club on a number of occasions. The first of which was back in 2000 when he came to talk to us about his Ambassadorial Scholarship.

He was originally from Paw Paw, Michigan, and I guess he loves our weather so much that he decided that he'd settle here in Perth.

Troy has worked at Curtin University, and is now at Stanley College.

TOPIC: Where has the Love Gone

As it is Valentine's Day today, Troy wanted us to be reminded that any relationship is affected by the other person's perceptions. Simple differences can quickly escalate into something more, when the perception of the other person is that their needs are not being met.

Troy provided us with some information from a book by Gary Chapman, called "The 5 Love Languages". He had us fill in a questionnaire that showed us what our preferences were when we want love to be shown to us.

The five big ticket items were:

- Being provided with words of affirmation
- Having quality time with your partner
- Receiving gifts
- Doing acts of service for the partner
- Being physically touched to show you care.

When one partner's main language is one thing, and the partner's is another, then a mismatch could occur. This could mean that the partner don't see the love behind your actions. The intention (yours) doesn't match with perception (theirs). According to Troy, perception trumps intention every time. Change is not impossible, so find a new way to fill those perceptions.
