**GUEST SPEAKER: Hazel Ruby**

**Topic:** Transition Planning

Hazel's background as a manager, trainer, coach and mentor provided her with good grounding to get involved in the work she currently does to assist people who are facing either voluntary retirement or forced redundancy. Her passion is to help people and she delivers courses and coaching programs around personal and business development themes.

She was in financial services – licences and compliances – and helped people to plan for their future regarding ensuring they had sufficient income stream to be able to do what they wanted to do.

Hazel found that many people, once they retire find themselves without a sense of fulfilment, or sense of purpose and she wanted to help people work out how to develop their sense of purpose and fulfilment.

She has created some programs that include opportunities to reflect on a number of areas, including being physically healthy, being mentally stimulated, engaging with their creative side, building relationships, getting involved in activities that are a passion, financial health. There are about 10 areas for self discovery through her programs.

Several vignettes were provided showing how important it is to be able to identify what are the things that are roadblocks to your successes in the future; what are the things that you are passionate about that can become your focus for the future; so that you can have a purposeful future.
