## Noel Allen's Rotary Journey

However, my biggest project, Bali Schoolkids Program, started 20 years ago.

Starting with just 3 children it has now seen 2,100 kids gain 6 years of primary schooling.

Along the way we also managed 200 cleft palate operations

2 x 6 month nutrition programs for 120 kids each.

Provided 4 Shelterboxes

Untold health checks for families at the Annual Distribution Days.
