The Cannington office has a Core staff of 10, with several specialised people working with clients from there.

75% of their clients are 25 years or younger, the broad age group being from 12 - 25. Headspace is connected to National Youth Mental Health, is Federally funded & is a free service.

Headspace will go to Parents Nights at Schools, attempt early intervention at High Schools, & work with other groups such as Lifeline, Centre Care & Helping Minds to provide the most comprehensive help & achieve outcomes.
