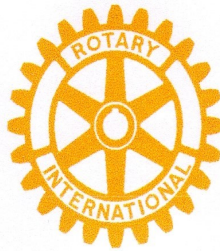

Did you know?

There are 3 strains of wild poliovirus?

Type 2 was eradicated in 1999 and no case of wild poliovirus type 3 has been found since November 2012.

Type 1 is still found in 2 countries and so far this year only 11 cases have been reported.

There is no cure for polio, it can only be prevented. Polio vaccine, given multiple times can protect a child for life.
