#### **UPDATE FROM TIMOR:**

They are asking if we can continue to support them. Currently asking for \$1500 for a new water pump. Those at the meeting agreed we could go ahead as we have available funds.

Another project to install a 200,000 L water tank is being budgeted and we have been asked if we can contribute some funds towards its purchase and installation. Likely overall cost is about \$US2-3 million.

#### **BRICKTOBER UPDATE:**
