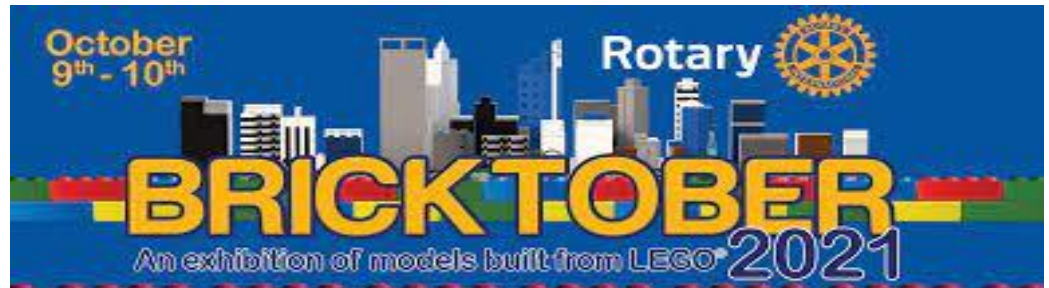

GUEST SPEAKER: Jennifer Keen WA State Manager OZHARVEST



From their warehouse in East Perth OZHARVEST provide Rescued Food to clients from Peel to Yanchep to Armadale.

They have a fleet of 8 bright yellow vans (easy to see), with which they pick up food from various donors (Woolies & other Commercial Outlets). All the food is fresh & is redistributed the same day to various charitable agencies.

Covid19 has created a few logistical problems, with Optus Stadium calling them to take all the food that was ordered for a footy game. This is what you call an A class problem.

OZHARVEST also run "Cooking for a Cause" where qualified chefs' run cooking classes for clients and all proceeds go to OZHARVEST. These are run as team building exercises for corporate clients

One of the Charitable Agencies has a budget to provide 5 meals a day (breakfast, morning tea, lunch, afternoon tea & dinner for \$6.10 per person day and is very grateful for the donations.

President Alan thanked Jen for giving us a run down on what OZHARVEST is all about & presented her with a cheque for \$3000 to help them in their endeavours.as
