UPDATE ON WORK IN EAST TIMOR

Mike Bermann provided us with a quick update on the current project Number 11 which is providing clean water to Lete Foho. The terrain is very rugged, but some 2,000 people will benefit from this fresh supply of water. In the mix of equipment we have supplied: 17 water tanks, 2 pumps, 6,000 metres of polypipe, 250 metres of fencing, 30 tap stands, 10 Gabian boxes, 17 sets of metal roofing covers plus a whole host of connectors and accessories to make it all work.

Well done everyone. Great job.

Sue Alexander (who first alerted us to the possibility of providing help in this area) was blown away to see all the work that has been done.

Thank you everyone for supporting the handbags and contents to deliver to those in need. Some 20 handbags will be handed out and another 20 will be donated to Jacaranda to give out as Christmas presents.
