## MEMBERSHIP

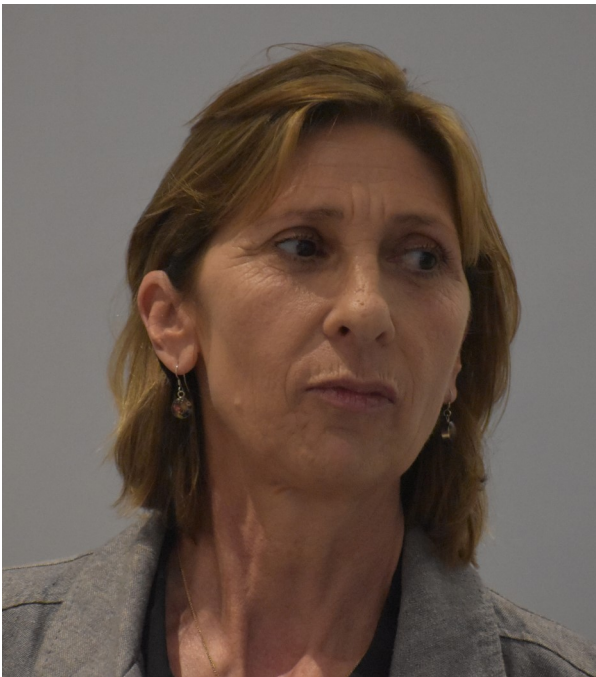
