### CHRISTMAS HAMPERS ARE ON AGAIN

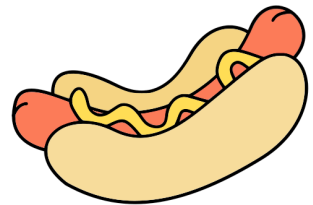
