

Technical Scholarship and the Lowell K. Levy Hard Work Scholarship Opportunities

This application packet is only for students who

- have already graduated from high school or
- ➤ live in Cedarburg or Grafton but are not attending Cedarburg High School or Grafton High School. If you are enrolled in either the Cedarburg or Grafton high schools, apply through the guidance department of that school.

Qualified students must have been residents of Cedarburg or Grafton school districts while in high school.

The purpose of the Technical Scholarship is to help students who want to pursue a technical or vocational career. The scholarship is for anyone who plans to enroll in a technical college, vocational school, or trade school. The scholarship may be valued up to \$4,000.

The purpose of the Lowell K. Levy Hard Work Scholarship is to help students who want to pursue a technical or a non-technical career. The scholarship is for anyone who plans to enroll in either a 2-year technical college, or a 4-year university. The scholarship may be valued up to \$5,000. This scholarship is in memory of Rotary Club of Cedarburg-Grafton charter member Lowell Kenneth Levy. Lowell was the consummate hard worker, and his life and career exemplified all the good that comes from it. Applicants who have demonstrated service above self and hard work through school, employment, and activities are encouraged to apply.

These scholarships were established to help you defray the cost of your education. The scholarships may be used for tuition, books, transportation, or any other necessary school expense. Criteria considered for these scholarships includes: effort and determination, coursework experience, job experience, and need. They are available to students regardless of class rank.

To apply for these scholarships, please do the following steps:

- 2. Include your high school transcripts.
- 3. Have someone other than a relative write a letter of recommendation for you. Have them send the letter to the address below.
