Process For Proposing A New Member

1. Rotarian member must work with a proposed member to fill out the Membership Proposal and Application. (page 2 of brochure)
2. Rotarian member must sign and date the application, then submit it to the President or Secretary.
3. Board reviews application and votes on whether to approve the membership.
4. If Board vote is successful, the secretary will post the name of the prospective member to the full membership for a 10 day comment period.
5. After a successful comment period, member will introduce proposed member as new member at a meeting and new member will be presented with the new member packet.
6. New members will be invited to provide classification talk at a future meeting.
7. New members are invited to attend annual *Fireside Chat* as a new member orientation.
8. Rotarian who presented the proposed member shall serve as a mentor for the new member if desired.
