Rotary Safety Center – the Rotary Safety Center opened in May 1981 as the result of the commitment and generosity of Rotarians, businesses, and individuals within the community. The center which is operated by the Kenosha Police Department teaches children as well as adults the importance of safety including bicycle safety, pedestrian safety, seatbelt usage, poison dangers, household dangers, dangers of the friendly stranger, and how to make emergency phone calls.
