## “SERVICE ABOVE SELF” SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Each year, the Menasha Rotary Club awards **four \$750 scholarships** to graduating seniors **who reside within the Menasha Joint School District**. This is offered to students from Menasha High School and St. Mary Catholic High School. These scholarships are awarded to students who have demonstrated concern for their community through activities, service projects, volunteering or other activities.

These scholarships are one-time, non-renewable scholarships. The students receiving the scholarships must attend a 2 or 4 year college or technical school as a full-time student for the academic year following award of the scholarships. **Please note: Menasha Rotary Club will send the scholarship funds directly to the educational institution chosen by the award recipient, as soon as the recipient provides the Menasha Rotary Club Scholarship Committee with proof of admission and enrollment in a full semester of classes.**

**To apply for this scholarship, students must submit a written letter (not just a resume) containing ALL of the following information:**

1. The student’s full name, mailing address, telephone number, and email address.
2. Names of the student’s parents.
3. The student’s date of birth.
4. Name and address of the college or technical school the student will be attending, along with an explanation of why that school was chosen. (If the student has not finalized a decision on schools, a list of the schools being considered.)
5. Summary of the student’s involvement in community activities and service projects, including dates of such involvement, along with an explanation of the student’s reasons for participating in those activities and what the student learned from such participation.
6. Summary of the student’s involvement in extracurricular activities.
7. A summary of the student’s career goals.
8. The student’s view as to why he or she is the best candidate for the Service Above Self Scholarship.
9. Written recommendations from at least two teachers or one teacher and one guidance counselor.
10. A copy of up-to-date high school transcript.
11. Proof of a high school cumulative grade-point average of at least 2.75 on a 4.0 scale.
