Scholarship Specifics: Early Bird Rotary provides one-year technical college scholarships of variable amounts up to \$2000. These are tuition scholarships only and applicable to any technical college in Wisconsin. Applications will be reviewed quarterly on 3/31, 6/30, 9/30 and 12/31, annually. Decisions will be made within 45 days of each quarter-end.

An Adult Applicant is someone that graduated high school (or equivalent) within the past year or more.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a Sheboygan County resident
- Must be planning to attend (or currently attending) a technical college in Wisconsin.
- Has financial need or hardship.
- Demonstrated leadership qualities at work or through volunteer activities. Exhibits good judgement and thoughtful decision making.

Our objective is to provide financial assistance that supports self-improvement, enhances job opportunities, and sustains and improves a quality workforce. Further we wish to introduce applicants to Rotary whose motto is Service Above Self.
