**Greg Jacobs and Gene Nelson** went fishing on the Kenai River in Alaska. Some great looking fish were to be had.





## 🍎 THE PROGRAM 🍎

**Les Crawford** introduced this afternoon’s guest speakers, Rob, Nick & Rick. No last names. They represent a group of men who belong to a volunteer organization called “**Men Evolving Non-Violently**” (M.E.N) It was founded in 1979 to address issues of abuse of women and children. Over 4,000 men have gone through this program.





The program is designed to help men get out of layers of anger issues and see what is actually going on. M.E.N. is a one of a kind program that offers several services to help men who have decided they want to change their abusive or unproductive behavior. The initial program is 14 weeks with a minimum \$20 donation.

The donations collected are distributed to charities that serve victims of abuse. Their philosophy is that the domestic violence problem will only change when men change.



Anger issues and domestic violence are addressed. They work with men who do not know how to express themselves in a non-violent manner. The volunteers help these men dealing with blaming, justifying, distorting, minimizing and externalizing. There followed an extensive session with written questions

from the audience.

**Continuing with October's theme of Family Safety and Domestic Violence Protection the committee will introduce Dr Jackson Katz Ph.d at the meeting on October 12**



## Future Programs:

### **October 5: State Senator Mike McGuire**



Senator Mike McGuire is a third generation Northern Californian, whose family farmed prunes and grapes in the Alexander Valley for nearly a half century. Raised by his mom and grandma, Mike worked his way through high school and college and enjoyed a career in the radio and television industries.

Mike was first elected to the Healdsburg School Board when he was 19. As one of Northern California's youngest school board presidents, he led successful efforts to rebuild local decaying schools.

In 2004, Mike was elected to the Healdsburg City Council where he was the city's youngest mayor and was instrumental in creating one of the most successful local economies and stable municipal budgets in the region.

In 2010, Mike was elected to the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors. He has been a tireless advocate for our environment, and helped lead efforts that turned years of deficits into a multi-million dollar surplus and made Sonoma County one of top counties in job growth in California.

Mike has always been a tireless advocate for our environment. He has helped protect and preserve tens of thousands of acres of open space, watersheds and coast and he successfully fought to keep our regional and state parks open to the public.

Mike was sworn into office on December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014, and represents the Second Senate District, which stretches from the Golden Gate Bridge to the Oregon Border. The district includes Del Norte, Trinity, Humboldt, Lake, Mendocino, Sonoma and Marin counties.

Mike attended Santa Rosa Junior College and graduated from Sonoma State University. He is married to local high school teacher and middle school assistant-principal, Erika McGuire. Erika and Mike live in Healdsburg.
