I am sure one of the reasons we have embarked on exchange again is we found an outstanding candidate, Connor Ovens, whose mother Chris is a former exchange student and whose grandfather is a long time member of Rotary.

We also supported two year 12 students to attend the National Youth Science Forum in Canberra, as well one participant in the RYPEN program and one for RYLA. However we were not successful in establishing a Rotaract Club, but this is a work in progress. Youth Service Director **Suresh Prabhakaran** worked very hard to bring this to fruition and is committed to continuing this effort. We brought our neighbouring Rotary Clubs of Attadale and Booragoon on board, and will continue to work with them and hopefully Rotary Club of Melville to finish the job in 2019-2020.

The Speakers Program continued to provide much food for thought, and was managed well by **Lorri Brazier**, while the Applecross Advocate (AA) transitioned to a template using the Rotary ClubRunner technology, and was taken over by one of the developers of that software, our member **Ray Philp**.

Applecross Rotary continued to be well managed administratively and financially, thanks this year to our Secretary **Chris Whelan** and Treasurer **Jason Tay**.

Applecross Rotary owes much to the foresight of previous leaders in the establishment of the Annual Applecross Rotary Jacaranda Festival, now firmly positioned on the year's calendar on the fourth Saturday in November. Thank you **Kenn Williams** for your continued leadership. More recently, the funding raised through the efforts of **Chris Whelan** in managing the volunteers at the Perth Makers Market, held on at least six Sundays through the year, has enabled the Club to become financially secure and able to assist a large number of organisations. A list of these is included in the report. The Annual Rotary Art Show, held at Garden City also provided valuable funds to help the Club's community outreach, and our thanks go to **John and Jan Hosking** for their work with Rotary Club of Melville in making the event such a success.
