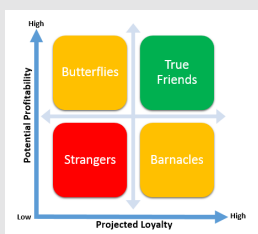

SET UP YOUR ORGANISATION'S SCHEME ID

DEFINE THE REFUND AMOUNT WITH YOUR DONATION PARTNER

Once you have agreed on a relationship between your organisation and the donation partner, the refund donation amount is added to the Greenbatch Foundation Service Level Agreement (GFSLA)

GREENBATCH FOUNDATION COLLECTIONS

Once the GFSLA is signed and first payment is received, the infrastructure if required, is supplied to the donation partner and collections can begin. CDS eligible containers can be identified by the labeling stating they can be refunded.

Non CDS items that are accepted include all HDPE and PET plastic products and glass wine bottles



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REFUNDS

The refund is paid to the donor within 7 business days of the collection being received.

100% of the 10c per eligible container is refunded to the donor partners as directed by the GFSLA.
