Since then, I've been very active in promoting my business, including giving talks to Rotary clubs (both Perth and country), been on the radio, set up my website and Facebook presence, produced sample films, done targeted advertising, met with not-for-profit groups, cold called and spoken to as many people as I can. My 'product' has altered since my initial idea, which came about largely from all the interactions I've had, and feedback received, during this period.

I truly believe that people's life stories and history, particularly the elderly, are precious. Take for example my grandfather, who died in a work accident well before I was born (in fact when my mother was just a young adult). How could she have known the morning she said goodbye as he left for work would be the last.

All that's left are her memories, some old photos and his wristwatch – the glass of which is smashed from the accident. I never understood as a child why her eyes welled up whenever I asked about him. Now, of course, I do.
