President Terry officiated at his first meeting for 2024/25, Partner Tish came along in support, all went off without a hitch.

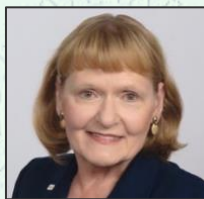
Guest speakers tonight were Jenny Marslen and Nicole Beard from the City of Kwinana, both ladies are heavily involved in community work with the City.

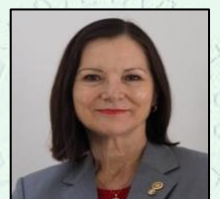

The prime reason of their visit tonight is the upgrades proposed for Apex Rotary Park, which is situated just north of Summerton Road, Medina.

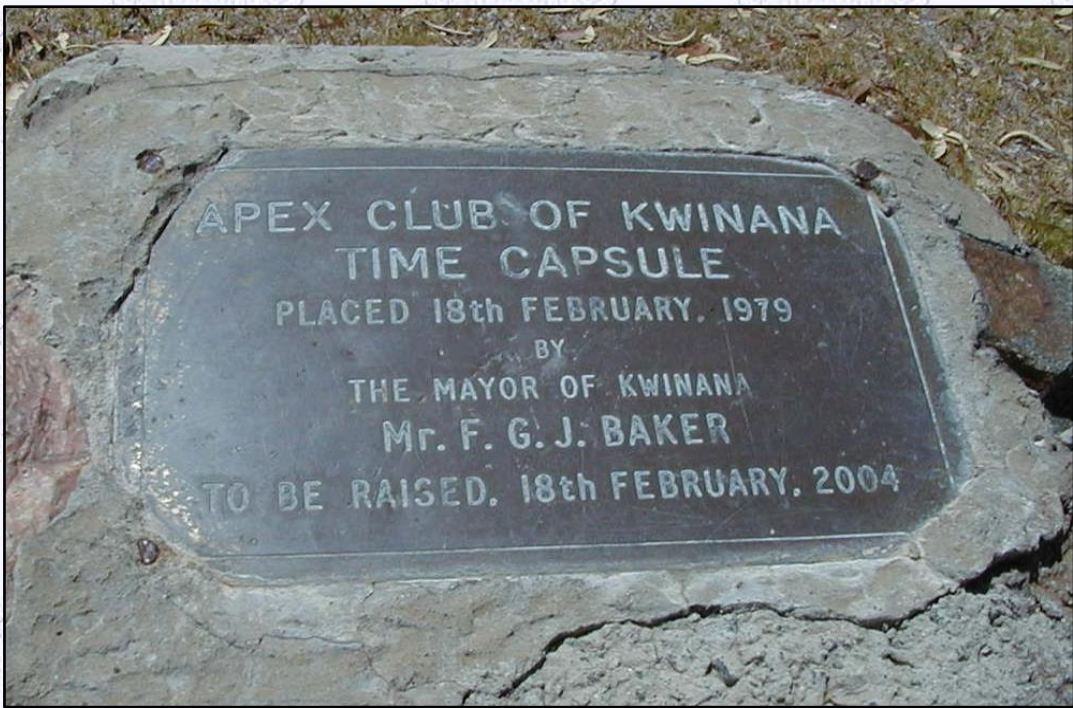
The proposed improvements have been the result of extensive consultation between all interested stakeholders, a draft plan was shown to the meeting.

The Park originally established by Apex. A Time Capsule was interned by Apex in February 1979, to be raised in February 2004.

This was done under the guidance of Kwinana Rotary. February 2004.

Some improvements were made in 2006 when an old wooden pergola was removed by the Kwinana Rotary Club members and replaced by a new structure, the park was then renamed Apex Rotary Park.

The GPEI has published a new technical brief; [Building a Climate-Resilient Polio-Free World](#), which highlights the intersection of the climate crisis and polio eradication, offering valuable insights into how we can both deliver a polio-free world and ensure a climate-resilient future.

- Afghanistan: 11 WPV1-positive environmental samples
- Pakistan: three WPV1-positive environmental samples
- Liberia: two cVDPV2-positive environmental samples
- Nigeria: one cVDPV2 case
- Sierra Leone: one cVDPV2-positive environmental sample
